## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR ONLINE BID SUBMISSION**

The Director, AIIMS Mangalagiri, invites E-Bids in Two Bid System (i.e., Technical and Financial Bid) from eligible Manufacturers / Direct Importers/ Authorized distributor online through E-procurement solution portal <https://eprocure.gov.in/> on mutually agreed terms and conditions and satisfactory performance for: – Tender for procurement of posterior vitrectomy machine for ophthalmology department at AIIMS, Mangalagiri

### **1. REGISTRATION**

- a) Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: <https://eprocure.gov.in/> ) by clicking on the link “Online bidder Enrollment” on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.
- b) As part of the enrollment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- c) Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- d) Upon enrollment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g., Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.
- e) Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC’s to others which may lead to misuse.
- f) Bidder then logs in to the site through the secured log-in by entering their user ID /password and the password of the DSC / e-Token.

### **2. SEARCHING FOR TENDER DOCUMENTS**

- A. There are various search options built in the CPP Portal, to facilitate bidders to search active tenders by several parameters. These parameters could include Tender ID, Organization Name, Location, Date, Value, etc. There is also an option of advanced search for tenders, wherein the bidders may combine a number of search parameters such as Organization Name, Form of Contract, Location, Date, Other keywords etc. to search for a tender published on the CPP Portal.
- B. Once the bidders have selected the tenders they are interested in, they may download the required documents / tender schedules. These tenders can be moved to the respective ‘My Tenders’ folder. This would enable the CPP Portal to intimate the bidders through SMS / e- mail in case there is any corrigendum issued to the tender document.
- C. The bidder should make a note of the unique Tender ID assigned to each tender; in case they want to obtain any clarification / help from the Helpdesk.

### **3. PREPARATION OF BIDS**

- i) Please go through the tender advertisement and the tender document carefully to understand the documents required to be submitted as part of the bid. Any deviations from these may lead to rejection of the bid.

- ii) Bidder, in advance, should get ready the bid documents to be submitted as indicated in the tender document / schedule and generally, they can be in PDF / XLS / RAR / DWF/JPG formats. Bid documents may be clearly scanned with 100 dpi option which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.
- iii) To avoid the time and effort required in uploading the same set of standard documents which are required to be submitted as a part of every bid, a provision of uploading such standard documents (e.g. PAN card copy, auditor certificates etc.) has been provided to the bidders. Bidders can use “My Space” or “Other Important Documents” area available to them to upload such documents. These documents may be directly submitted from the “My Space” area while submitting a bid, and need not be uploaded again and again. This will lead to a reduction in the time required for bid submission process.

#### **4. CORRIGENDUM**

- a) At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the purchaser may, for any reason deemed fit by it, modify the Tender Enquiry Document by issuing suitable Corrigendum to it.
- b) Corrigendum in technical specification issued after pre-bid meeting will be final & no corrigendum will be issued thereafter.
- c) Corrigendum will be notified through <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> and website of AIIMS Mangalagiri.

#### **5. SUBMISSION OF BIDS:**

- a) Bidder should log into the site well in advance for bid submission so that they can upload the bid in time i.e., on or before the bid submission time. Bidder will be responsible for any delay due to other issues.
- b) The bidder has to digitally sign and upload the required bid documents one by one as indicated in the tender document.
- c) Bidders are requested to note that they should necessarily submit their financial bids in the format provided and no other format is acceptable. If the price bid has been given as a standard BOQ format with the tender document, then the same is to be downloaded and to be filled by all the bidders. Bidders are required to download the BOQ file, open it and complete the white colored (unprotected) cells with their respective financial quotes and other details (such as name of the bidder). No other cells should be changed. Once the details have been completed, the bidder should save it and upload it online, without changing the filename. If the BOQ file is found to be modified by the bidder, the bid will be rejected.
- iv) The server time (which is displayed on the bidders’ dashboard) will be considered as the standard time for referencing the deadlines for submission of the bids by the bidders, opening of bids etc. The bidders should follow this time during bid submission.
- v) All the documents being submitted by the bidders will be encrypted using PKI encryption techniques to ensure the secrecy of the data. The data entered cannot be viewed by unauthorized persons until the time of bid opening. The confidentiality of the bids is maintained using the secured Socket Layer 128-bit encryption technology.
- vi) Data storage encryption of sensitive fields is done. Any bid document that is uploaded to the server is subjected to symmetric encryption using a system generated symmetric key. Further this key is subjected to asymmetric encryption using buyers/bid opens public keys.

- vii) The uploaded tender documents become readable only after the tender opening by the authorized bid openers.
- viii) Upon the successful and timely submission of bids (i.e. after Clicking “Freeze Bid Submission” in the portal), the portal will give a successful bid submission message & a bid summary will be displayed with the bid no. and the date & time of submission of the bid with all other relevant details.
- ix) The bid summary has to be printed and kept as an acknowledgement of the submission of the bid. This acknowledgement may be used as an entry pass for any bid opening meetings.

## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (GIB)**

### **1. Preamble:-**

- i) **Pre-Bid Meeting:** - The pre-bid Tender meeting will be held on 07.06.2021 3PM by Virtual (ZOOM) meeting. Joining link for Pre – Bid meeting will be made available on [www.aiimsmanagalagiri.edu.in](http://www.aiimsmanagalagiri.edu.in) website under tender's section. The agency(s) may get clarified any confusion regarding any terms and condition of the contract during pre-bid meeting and thereafter any claim of doubt/confusion or any things relating to this contract will not be entertained and it will be deemed that the agency has understood everything about this tender. Based on queries of the bidders, committee members will decide to issue any amendments/corrigendum for the tender.
- ii) **Eligibility of Bidders:-** Before formulating the tender and submitting the same to the purchaser, the bidder should read and examine all the terms, conditions, instructions, checklist, Technical specifications, etc. contained in the Tender documents. Failure to provide and/or comply with the required information, instructions etc. incorporated in these tender documents may result in rejection of its tender.
- iii) **Availability of fund:-** Expenditure to be incurred for the proposed purchase will be met from the funds available with the purchaser/consignee
- iv) **Language of Tender:-**The tender submitted by the bidder and all subsequent correspondence and documents relating to the tender exchanged between the bidder and the purchaser, shall be written in English language, unless otherwise specified in the Tender Enquiry. However, the language of any printed literature furnished by the bidder in connection with its tender may be written in any other language provided the same is accompanied by an English translation and, for purposes of interpretation of the tender, the English translation shall prevail.  
The tender submitted by the bidder and all subsequent correspondence and documents relating to the tender exchanged between the bidder and the purchaser, may also be written in the Hindi language, provided that the same are accompanied by English translation, in which case, for purpose of interpretation of the tender etc, the English translations shall prevail.
- v) **Tendering Expenses:-** The bidder shall bear all costs and expenditure incurred and/or to be incurred by it in connection with its tender including preparation, mailing and submission of its tender and for subsequent processing the same. The purchaser will, in no case be responsible or liable for any such cost, expenditure etc regardless of the conduct or outcome of the tendering process.
- vi) **Corrigendum to Tender Documents:-**
  - a) At any time prior to the deadline for submission of bids, the purchaser may, for any reason deemed fit by it, modify the Tender Enquiry Document by issuing suitable Corrigendum to it.
  - b) Corrigendum in technical specification issued after pre-bid meeting will be final & no corrigendum will be issued thereafter.

- vii) **Clarification of Tender Documents: -**
  - a) Any queries relating to the tender document and the terms and conditions contained therein should be addressed to the Tender Inviting Authority for a tender or the relevant contact person indicated in the tender.
  - b) Any queries relating to the process of online bid submission or queries relating to CPP Portal in general may be call directed to the 24x7 CPP Portal Helpdesk.

- 2. Tender currencies: -**
  - a) The bidder supplying indigenous goods or already imported goods shall quote only in Indian Rupees (INR).
  - b) Bids, where prices are quoted in any other way shall be treated as non - responsive and will be rejected.
- 3. Tender Prices: -**
  - a) The bidder shall indicate all specified components of prices shown therein on the Price Schedule provided in BoQ including the unit prices, applicable taxes and total bid prices of goods and services. It proposes to supply against the requirement. The entire column shown in BoQ should be filled up as required. Cost per Test will be considered for Price evaluation.
  - b) After due evaluation of the bid(s) Institute will award the contract to the responsive bidder, who has quoted the lowest Price per test on cumulative basis as per category.
- 4. Firm Prices: -** The quoted rates must be valid for a period for 24 months from the date agreement. The overall offer for the assignment and bidder(s) quoted price shall remain unchanged during the period of validity. If the bidder quoted the validity shorter than the required period, the same will be treated as unresponsive and it may be rejected
- 5. Bid validity: -**
  - a. The bids shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of 180 days (One hundred and Eighty days) after the date of tender opening prescribed in the tender document. Any tender valid for a shorter period shall be treated as unresponsive and rejected.
  - b. In exceptional cases, the bidders may be requested by the purchaser to extend the validity of their tenders up to a specified period. Such request(s) and responses thereto shall be conveyed by email. The bidders, who agree to extend the tender validity, are to extend the same without any change or modification of their original tender.
  - c. In case the day up to which the tenders are to remain valid falls on / subsequently declared a holiday or closed day for the purchaser, the tender validity shall automatically be extended up to the next working day.
- 6. Non- responsive tender: -**Non submission of the following are some of the important aspects, for which a tender shall be declared non – responsive during the evaluation and will be ignored:
  - a) Tender Acceptance Form as per Annexure-I (signed & stamped) not uploaded.
  - b) Bid validity is shorter than the required period.
  - c) Required Bid Security (Amount, validity etc.)/ Exemption documents have not been uploaded as per stipulated provisions.
  - d) Bidder has not agreed to give the required performance security of required amount in an acceptable form for due performance of the contract.
  - e) Bidder has not agreed to other essential condition(s) specially incorporated in the Tender document like terms of payment, liquidated damages clause, comprehensive warranty clause, dispute resolution mechanism, and applicable law.
  - f) Poor/unsatisfactory past performance.
  - g) Bidders who stand de-registered/ banned/ blacklisted by any Central Govt. Ministries/ Departments/ Hospitals/Institutes.
  - h) Bidder has not agreed for the delivery terms and delivery schedule.
- 7. Discrepancies in Prices:** The Bidder(s) shall quote Rate up-to two decimals only. Bidder(s) to note that only first two decimals shall be considered for evaluation if quotation having more than two decimals.
- 8. Price Preference Policy and Exemption for submission of various eligibility Criteria documents to the Bidder Registered under Make in India Initiative: -**



The Bidder Companies, those have registered under Make in India initiative and producing their products under “**Make in India Policy of Government of India**” shall be given Price Preference as per Govt. of India applicable Rules and Guidelines on submission of relevant certificate (i.e. Make In India Certification) for availing the Price Preference and Exemption for submission of exempted documents against this bid along with their Pre-Qualification Bid Documents. If the no bidder will upload/submit the requested “Make in India” Certificate along with their Bid, it will be treated as open tender bid and no preference shall be given to such BIDDERS on producing “Make in India” Certification in later bid stage.

**Price preference to “Make in India” product shall be as follows:**

- a. If the “Make in India” product and other products are at the same price range, preference shall be given to “Make in India” product.
- b. If the “Make in India” product is not L1, however it is within the 5% range of L1 price, option shall be given to the “Make in India” product to match the L1 price and to quote a price lower than L1 vendor.

In addition, as per recent instructions, dt. 23.6.2020, no. 39-60/2020-A.C from Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution, any item made in China cannot be purchased through GeM and other sources.

**9. Bidder’s capability to perform the contract:**

- a) The purchaser, through the above process of tender scrutiny and tender evaluation will determine to its satisfaction whether the bidder, who’s tender, has been determined as the lowest evaluated responsive tender is eligible, qualified and capable in all respects to perform the contract satisfactorily. If, there is more than one schedule in the Schedule of Requirements, then, such determination will be made separately for each schedule.
- b) The above-mentioned determinations will inter-alia take into account the bidder’s financial, technical and production capabilities for satisfying all the requirements of the purchaser as incorporated in the Tender document. Such determination will be based upon scrutiny and examination of all relevant data and details submitted by the bidder in its tender as well as such other allied information as deemed appropriate by the purchaser.

**10. Contacting the Purchaser:** In case a bidder attempts to influence the purchaser in the purchaser’s decision on scrutiny, comparison & evaluation of tenders and awarding the contract, the tender of the bidder shall be liable for rejection in addition to appropriate administrative actions being taken against that bidder, as deemed fit by the purchaser.

**11. Purchaser’s Right to accept any tender and to reject any or all tenders**

The purchaser reserves the right to accept in part or in full any tender or reject any or more tender(s) without assigning any reason or to cancel the tendering process and reject all tenders at any time prior to award of contract, without incurring any liability, whatsoever to the affected bidder or bidders.

**12.** The bidder(s) must be submitted Tender Acceptance Form (Annexure-I) as acceptance of all terms & condition of the tender.

**13. Scrutiny and Evaluation of Tenders:-**

- i) Tenders will be evaluated on the basis of the terms & conditions already incorporated in the tender document, based on which tenders have been received and the terms, conditions etc. mentioned by the bidders in their tenders.

- ii) The Purchaser will examine the Tenders to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been made, whether required sureties have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed stamped.
- iii) The Tender/Bid will be opened online at website <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app> on Store office at AIIMS Mangalagiri Premises at the time of bid opening.
- iv) Only those financial bids will be opened whose technical bids are found suitable by the expert committee appointed for the concerned instrument/equipment.
- v) No separate information shall be given to individual bidders. In incomparable situation, the committee may negotiate price with the technically and financially qualified bidder before awarding the bid.

**14. Signing of Contract:** The successful bidder shall execute an agreement for ensuring satisfactory supply, installation, commissioning and the after sales service/support during the comprehensive warranty period and during the Comprehensive Annual Maintenance Contract.

**15. Award Criteria:** The Purchaser will award the contract to the bidder whose bid has been determined to be substantially responsive and who has bided the lowest evaluated bid price.

- i) Notwithstanding the above, the Purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any quotations and to cancel the bidding process and reject all quotations at any time prior to the award of contract
- ii) The bidder whose bid is accepted will be notified of the award of contract by the Purchaser prior to expiration of the bid validity period. The terms of the accepted bid shall be incorporated in the purchase order. The Director reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning reasons.

**16.** The Director reserves the right to modify, add or delete any terms & conditions of the contract as and when required.

## GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

### 1. **Pre-Qualification Criteria:**

- a. Bidder should be the manufacturer/authorized dealer/Distributor/Trader/ Supplier. Letter of Authorization from Manufacturer for the same and specific to the tender should be uploaded in the prescribed place.
- b. An undertaking from the original Manufacturer is required stating that they would facilitate the bidder on regular basis with technology/product updates and extend support for the warranty as well. The scanned copy of same to be uploaded (if applicable)

### 2. **Performance Security: -**

- a) The Successful Contractor will be required to furnish an amount 3% of total purchase value as a performance security in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt or Bank Guarantee from any Nationalized Bank duly pledged in the name of the " AIIMS, Mangalagiri " payable at Mangalagiri within 30 days from the award of contract. Security Deposit shall be kept valid for a period of 60 days beyond completion of all the contractual obligations. In case of the contract fails to submit the requisite PSD even after 60 days from the date of issue of LOA the contract shall be terminated duly forfeiting the EMD and other dues if any payable against the contract. The failed contractor shall be debarred from participating in re-tender (if any) for that item. Performance Security Deposit is mandatory.
- b) The security deposit can be forfeited by order of this Institute in the event of any breach or negligence or non-observance of any condition of contract or for unsatisfactory performance or non – observance of any condition of the contract.
- c) Successful supplier/firm should submit performance Security Deposit as prescribed in favour of "AIIMS, Mangalagiri" and to be received in the *office of Sr. Store Officer, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Dharmshala Building, AIIMS Mangalagiri, Guntur-522503* before the date of commencement of supply or 30 days from the date of acceptance of the purchase order, whichever is earlier. The Performance Security Deposit to be furnished in the form of Bank Guarantee as per given Performa of the tender documents, for an amount covering 3% of the contract value.
- d) Validity of the Performance Security Deposit shall be for a period of 60 days beyond of entire warranty period from the date of issue of installation & commissioning

### 3. **Delivery & Installation (if applicable):** The successful bidder should strictly adhere to the following delivery schedule supply of above instruments should be affected within 6 Week from the date of purchase order and this clause should be strictly adhere to failing which administrative action as deemed fit under rules will be taken against the defaulter. Otherwise, Liquidation Damages will be imposed as per clause no. 4. Purchase order will be placed as required by consignee.

### 4. **Penalty:** If the suppliers fails to deliver and place any or all the Equipment or perform the service by the specified date as mention in purchase order, penalty at the rate of 0.5% per week of delayed value of goods subject to the maximum of 10% of delayed goods value will be deducted, afterwards another penalty may be imposed.

### 5. **Penalties for non-performance**

The penalties to be imposed, at any stage, under this tender are;

- a) imposition of liquidated damages,
- b) forfeiture of performance security,
- c) termination of the contract,
- d) Blacklisting/debarring of the bidder.

### 6. **Sample (if required):** suppliers need to provide sample at AIIMS Mangalagiri to the

nominated person of AIIMS Mangalagiri at their cost AIIMS Mangalagiri will not bear any training or living expenditure in this regard.

7. **Training and Demonstration (If required):** Suppliers needs to provide adequate training and demonstration at AIIMS Mangalagiri to the nominated person of AIIMS Mangalagiri at their cost. AIIMS Mangalagiri will not bear any training or living expenditure in this regard. The Supplier should arrange for regular weekly visit to the AIIMS, Mangalagiri campus by its technical team and assist in maintenance of the item/equipment within warranty period. Assistance limited to locking companies with manufacturer will not be considered sufficient

14. **Force Majeure:** If, at any time during the subsistence of this contract, the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reasons of any war or hostility, act of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fire, floods, exception, epidemics, quarantine restriction, strikers lockout or act of God (hereinafter referred to as events) provided notice of happening of any such eventuality is given by party to other within 21 days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance and deliveries have been so resumed or not shall be final and conclusive. Further, that if the performance in whole or in part of any obligation under this contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any such event for a period exceeding 60 days, AIIMS,

Mangalagiri party may, at least option to terminate the contract.

**15. Breach of Contract/Agreement:**

- c) **Payment of Indian Agency Commission:** Indian Agency commission will be paid to the manufacturer's agent in the local currency for an amount in Indian rupees indicated in the relevant Price Schedule (as per prevailing rate of exchange ruling on the date of Contract) and shall not be subject to further escalation/exchange variation. Payment shall be paid in Indian Rupees to the Indian Agent on proof of 100% payment to the Foreign Principal.
- 16.2 **Payment for Annual Comprehensive Maintenance Contract Charges:** The consignee will enter into CMC with the supplier at the rates as stipulated in the contract. - 16.3 The supplier shall not claim any interest on payments in any circumstance.

The enlistment under the scheme is not equivalent to the Registration with DGS&D. Such firms do not enjoy the same status as that of DGS&D registered suppliers. A note to this effect is given in the Enlistment Letter to the firm.
- 19. Custom Duty on Imported Goods** In respect of imported goods, the tenderers shall also specify separately the total amount of custom duty included in the quoted price. The tenderers should also indicate correctly the rate of custom duty applicable for the goods in question and the corresponding Indian Customs Tariff Number. **22. Fall Clause:**

- i) Prices charged for supplies under Rate Contract by the supplier should in no event exceed the lowest prices at which he bids to sell or sells the stores of identical description to any other State Government/DGS&D/Public Undertaking during the period of the contract.

- (i) The supplier shall not, without the purchaser’s prior written consent, disclose the contract or any provision thereof including any specification, drawing, sample or any information furnished by or on behalf of the purchaser in connection therewith, to any person other than the person(s) employed by the supplier in the performance of the contract emanating from this Tender document. Further, any such disclosure to any such employed person shall be made in confidence and only so far as necessary for the purposes of such performance for this contract.
- (ii) Further, the supplier shall not, without the purchaser’s prior written consent, make use of any document or information mentioned in this tender except for the sole purpose of performing this contract.
- (iii) Except the contract issued to the supplier, each and every other document mentioned in tender shall remain the property of the purchaser and, if advised by the purchaser, all copies of all such documents shall be returned to the purchaser on completion of the supplier’s performance and obligations under this contract.

The decision of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.

b) If the parties fail to resolve their dispute or difference by such mutual consultation within twenty- one days of its occurrence then, either the Purchaser/Consignee or the supplier may give notice to the other party of its intention to commence arbitration.
