# **ADMISSION NOTICE**

All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Mangalagiri invites applications for Entrance Examination for admission in Post Doctoral Certificate Courses (PDCC) in 'Pain medicine' under Dept. of Anaesthesiology & 'Cross Sectional Body Imaging' under department of Radiodiagnosis for the session September-2023.

## **Essential Qualification:**

MD/DNB in Anaesthesia/Radiodiagnosis recognized by Medical Council of India /NMC.

# 1) UPPER AGE LIMIT:

Upper age limit is 45 years as on closing date of application.

Upper age limit is relaxable for OBC Candidates by a maximum of 3 years.

Upper age limit is relaxable in case of SC/ST candidates by a maximum of 5 years.

Upper age limit is relaxable for Ex-Serviceman and Commissioned Officer including ECO, SSCO who have rendered or released on satisfactory assignment with age relaxation by a maximum of 5 years.

2) The persons with benchmark disabilities shall be given an upper age relaxation of five years for admission to PDCC for PWD candidates as per Right of persons with Disability Act, 2016.

## NOTE:

- a. For the purpose of application fee, the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/EWS/PWBD category, the candidate must possess a certificate issued by competent authority (as applicable to category/format provided by AIIMS Mangalagiri).
- b. OBC (NCL) certificate must be issued within one year of last date for application 28.08.2023 (i.e. issued between 27.08.2022 to 28.08.2023).
- c. EWS certificate should be issued on or after on 01.04.2023 to last date of filling of application form i.e. 28.08.2023 based on the income of year 2022-2023.
- d. ST/SC/PWBD certificate should be issued before the last of the application i.e. 28.08.2023

## 3) DURATION OF COURSE:

One (01) year. The tenure of training is one (01) year from the date of joining the course.

## NOTE:

- **Stage I:** Written test carrying 50 marks of 60 minutes duration in the subject candidate has applied for. Question paper will consist of 50 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs).
- **Stage II:** Out of candidates who have secured 50 percentile or more marks in written test (Stage-I), candidates 3 times number of seats advertised will be called for practical assessment (carrying 20 marks).
- **Final Selection:** Final result will be declared based on total marks obtained in stage-I and stage-II Examination.

## 6) SCHEME OF MARKING

The question paper will consist of 50 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) of 1 hour duration. There is no negative marking. Scheme of marking will be as follows:

Correct Answer: One mark (+1)Not answered: Zero mark (0)

## 7) METHOD OF SELECTION

Selection is based on the order of merit. The percentile scores will be used to determine the merit order. Merit list will be prepared as per percentile score.

## 8) METHOD OF RESOLVING TIES

If two or more candidates obtain equal percentile score in the entrance examination then their inter-se-merit for admission to the course shall be determined on the basis of the following: -

- i. A candidate senior in age will rank senior to the candidate junior in age.
- ii. If the age is also the same, then a candidate who has obtained higher marks (Aggregate) in the MBBS examination will rank senior to a candidate who has obtained lesser marks.

# 9) JOINING

Selected candidate is required to join on or before 16.09.2023. In any circumstances, last date for admission will not be extended. Candidates on the wait list who may be offered a seat if the selected candidates do not join.

## 10) EMOLUMENTS:

Pay as applicable to Senior Resident under Residency Scheme of Government of India. However, sponsored candidates are not entitled for any Stipend / Emoluments.

## 11) HOW TO APPLY

- A. The application form is enclosed at the end of this document. The candidate has to upload dully filled and signed application form (attached with this Admission Notice in the end) and send via mail to <a href="mailto:examcell@aiimsmangalagiri.edu.in">examcell@aiimsmangalagiri.edu.in</a>.
- B. Applicants must fill all the fields carefully since after submission of application request for change in any information at any later stage will not be considered.
- C. The candidates are requested to fill the correct details regarding name/ age/ sex/ caste/ address/ educational qualification and other relevant fields mentioned in the application.
- D. Candidates may please note that unless they make the payment of Application Fee, their application will be treated as INCOMPLETE.
- E. Payment of fee: Candidates can pay the application fee through NEFT. Additional charges viz. bank charges, service tax etc. incurred while making online payment of application fees will be borne by the candidate. Candidates are advised to take a print of the receipt of fee of Application Form for their records and future reference. Admit Card will be sent on the email of candidate (as provided in the application form) well in advance of the date of examination. (G) Payment of application fees by any other

mode viz Cash, Cheque, Money Orders, Postal Orders, Pay Orders, Banker's Cheques, Postal Stamps, etc., will not be accepted. Such applications will be summarily rejected. The decision of Director, AIIMS Mangalagiri in this regard shall be final and binding.

# 13) REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION OF OVERSEAS CITIZEN OF INDIA (OCI)

Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) registered under Section 7A of Citizenship Act 1955 are also eligible to appear in PDCC courses and all terms and conditions for Indian Nationals will be applicable to the candidates. The candidate will submit proof of Registration as OCI under Section 7A of Citizenship Act 1955 to be eligible to appear for this test.

# 14) SUBMISSION OF CASTE CERTIFICATE BY SC/ST/OBC/EWS CANDIDATES

The candidates who belong to category, has to submit attested copy of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe, Other Backward Classes and EWS as applicable, along with other requisite documents, from any one of the following authorities stating that the candidate belongs to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, Other Backward Classes or EWS in the prescribed form.

- A. District Magistrate, Additional District Magistrate, Collector, Deputy Commissioner, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Deputy Collector, 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate, City Magistrate, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Taluka Magistrate, Executive Magistrate, Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- B. Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate.
- C. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- D. Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and his or her family normally resides.
- E. Administrator/Secretary to Administrator/Development Officer (Lakshadweep Island) or as authorised in the Constitution.

The candidate will be required to submit an undertaking to the effect of their caste. The detection of any discrepancy in the caste certificate shall entail cancellation of registration. This is as per the provisions made by Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions vide their order No. 36033/4/97-Estt. (RES) dated 25.07.2003 and No. 36011/3/2005-Estt. (RES) dated 9.9.2005 respectively.

Candidates must note that a certificate from any other person/authority will not be accepted and no further correspondence in this regard shall be entertained. The name, designation and the seal of the officer should be legible in the certificate.

## 15) REASONS FOR REJECTION/CANCELLATION OF APPLICATION:

APPLICATIONS/CANDIDATURE LIABLE TO BE CANCELLED/REJECTED SUMMARILY OR AT ANY STAGE OF THE ADMISSION PROCESS IN THE EVENT OF ALL OR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

- i. Applications being incomplete.
- ii. Any variation in the Signatures.

All the SIGNATURES in FULL (NOT IN SHORT) done on the Print out of the Application Form and also on other Documents must be the same.

- iii. The photograph and signature pasted/uploaded in the application form is blur, distorted or not clear.
- iv. Non-payment of Examination Fees or non-receipt of fee through online mode, if not otherwise exempted.
- v. Fee not paid as per instructions.
- vi. Under aged/over aged candidates.
- vii. Failure to bring (in original) all relevant Certificates/Documents issued by the competent authority, along with self-attested legible copies in support of the information given in their Application Forms about their Educational Qualifications; Experiences; Percentage of Marks obtained; Proof of Age; Proof of Category [SC/ST/OBC] and the print out of Application Form at the time of verification of document.
- viii. Not having the requisite Educational Qualification/Experience/Category Status as on the closing date.
  - ix. Incorrect information or misrepresentation or suppression of material facts.
  - x. For carrying mobile phones / accessories in the Examination premises/Hall.
  - xi. Any other irregularity.

## 16) ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT

- (A) Candidates are warned that they should not furnish any particulars that are false or suppress any material information while filling in the application form. Candidates are also warned that they should in no case attempt to alter or otherwise tamper with any entry in a document or the attested certified copy submitted by them nor should they submit a tampered/fabricated document. If there is any inaccuracy or any discrepancy, an explanation regarding this discrepancy should be submitted.
- (B) Without prejudice to criminal action/debarment up to 3 years from examinations conducted by AIIMS, Mangalagiri wherever necessary, candidature will be summarily cancelled at any stage of the admission in respect of candidates found to have indulged in any of the following activities: -

- a. In possession of mobile phone and/or accessories and other electronic gadgets within the premises of the examination centers, whether in use or in switched off mode and on person or otherwise.
- b. Involved in malpractices.
- c. Using unfair means in the examination hall.
- d. Obtaining support for his/her candidature by any means.
- e. Impersonate/ procuring impersonation by any person.
- f. Submitting fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with.
- g. Making statements which are incorrect or false or suppressing material information.
- h. Resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for the examination.
- i. Misbehaving in any other manner in the examination hall with the Supervisor, Invigilator or supporting staff of AIIMS, Mangalagiri.
- j. Intimidating or causing bodily harm to the staff employed by AIIMS, Mangalagiri for the conduct of examination.

## 17) OTHER IMPORTANT POINTS

- i. Please fill the Application carefully. It may not be possible to make changes after submission of application. Applicants may note that further correspondence will NOT be entertained in this regard.
- ii. Any Amendment/Rectification/Change/Editing is NOT allowed in Name, Category, Department and PWBD status once submitted. Any change in address, mobile no. and email ID should be intimated to this office immediately.
- iii. The Competent Authority reserves the right of any amendment, cancellation and changes to this advertisement as a whole or in part without assigning any reason or giving notice.
- iv. In case, any information given or declaration by the candidate is found to be false or if the candidate has willfully suppressed any material information relevant to his/her admission, he/she will be liable to be removed from the institute and any action taken as deemed fit by the competent authority.
- v. The decision of the competent authority regarding selection of candidates will be final and no representation will be entertained in this regard.
- vi. Name of the selected candidates will be displayed in the institute website. No separate individual intimation will be sent. Beside, all information regarding examination will also be provided through the Institute website only. The Institute will not be responsible in any manner if a candidate fails to visit / access the website in time. Candidates are requested to regularly visit the Institute website i.e.www.aiimsmangalagiri.edu.in for updated information regarding the admission process.
- vii. The applicant will be responsible for the authenticity of submitted information, their documents and photograph. Submission of any false, fake and/or suppression /concealment of facts shall lead to rejection/ cancellation of admission.
- viii. There is no provision for re-checking/re-evaluation of the answer sheets and no query in this regard will be entertained.

- ix. The decision of the Director of the Institute shall be final in the matter of selection of candidates for admission to PDCC Course and no appeal will be entertained in this regard.
- x. Selected candidates must join the course on the date stipulated in the letter of selection, failing which the selection/admission shall stand cancelled/withdrawn.
- xi. The selected candidates will have to submit the original Permanent Registration Certificate at the time of reporting.
- xii. The selection of Senior Residents (PDCC) will be subject to medical fitness. No selected candidate will be permitted to pay course fee/join the course unless declared medically fit by the Medical Board constituted by the Institute. The decision of the Medical Board shall be final.
- xiii. Private practice in any form during the course is prohibited. The period of training is strictly full time and continuous.
- xiv. The rules are subject to change in accordance with the decision of the Institute to be taken from time to time.
- xv. Candidates are not allowed to bring mobile phones, books, notes and loose sheets, any other electronic gadgets and any other communication devices inside the examination premises/hall and any infringement of these instructions will entail debarment from future examinations of AIIMS Mangalagiri without prejudice to initiation of criminal proceedings against the candidates.
