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1. Introduction:

The All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Mangalagiri offers comprehensive research programs leading to the award of the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) degree. These programs are designed to foster high-quality research that contributes to the advancement of scientific knowledge and innovation. Research undertaken as part of the Ph.D. program may involve the development of novel interventions, evaluation of emerging scientific concepts, or exploration of fundamental biological processes.

The Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) degree is awarded to candidates who successfully complete original research and submit a thesis in accordance with the prescribed regulations. The research may be conducted within a specific discipline or through a multidisciplinary approach and should contribute significantly to the growth of knowledge in medical and interdisciplinary sciences. It may also focus on developing innovative applications of existing knowledge that have the potential to improve healthcare and benefit society.

The primary goal of the Ph.D. program is to nurture competent researchers and scientists capable of addressing contemporary challenges in Medical, Nursing, and Allied Health Sciences. The Institute provides an intellectually stimulating research environment supported by state-of-the-art infrastructure, advanced laboratories, modern equipment, and experienced faculty, enabling scholars to undertake impactful research aligned with the needs of the 21st century.

5. General Eligibility:

A Candidate seeking admission to course of study leading to award of a Degree of Doctor of Philosophy must possess at least one of following qualifications of a recognized University/Institute:

5.1 Qualification: (Specific qualification required is as mentioned in seat details)

- MD/MS/MDS/DM/M.Ch./ PG in AYUSH in subject concerned or Diplomate of National Board of Examinations with minimum of 55% aggregate marks or equivalent percentile.
- A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.
- Master degree (02-year course) awarded by Indian University or equivalent in subject as per requirement of project. Candidates holding MSc (Other than MSc Nursing), M Biotech/ M Tech degree /M Com / MBA or equivalent will be eligible. Candidates possessing Master's Degree through distant learning course shall not be eligible. Candidates should have at least 55% marks or equivalent in last eligibility examination qualified.
- The marks sheet of the Qualifications mentioned above does not mention the marks, the UG marksheet minimum 55% will be considered. The candidate should subject the evidence that the Institute or University does not provide the marks in qualified degree or affidavit in this regard.
- Candidate possessing Master's Degree through distant learning course shall not be eligible.

5.2 For external Candidates in permanent employment:

5.2.1 Candidates working under Central Govt./Semi Govt./Autonomous organization should submit their applications through proper channel i.e., employer. They will be required to submit a "No Objection Certificate" from their employer along with the application form before they are allowed to appear for the selection process of the Ph.D. Courses.

5.2.2 Also, such Candidates will have to provide a certificate at time of submission of synopsis from employer stating that in event of selection to PhD course, the Candidate will be granted for a minimum period of 02-year study leave with full pay and permission to work at AIIMS Mangalagiri to pursue full time PhD Course.

5.3 In-service-Candidates:

5.3.1 Applicants (Regular/Tenure basis) from AIIMS Mangalagiri whose tenure is of 3 years or more - Faculty/Nursing staff/Administrative officials/Scientific staff, SR, JR, Tutors and Demonstrators may apply as Internal Candidates.

5.3.2 Candidate who gets a permanent employment after completion of 2-year PhD course can continue their PhD work as Non-residential Candidate till the completion of PhD.

5.4 Requirements for Admission of Foreign Nationals (SAARC Applicants)

- Sponsorship certificate in the format prescribed in the Prospectus, duly completed and signed by the competent authority.
- NOC from Ministry of Health & Family Welfare in case of Foreign Nationals.
- The foreign nationals are required to send their registration form of application through Diplomatic Channel. They are also required to appear in the Interview along with other candidates. An 'Advance Copy' to be submitted at AIIMS, Mangalagiri (Email id: pa.deana@aiimsmangalagiri.edu.in) before

the last date of registration. However, the application of all such candidates will be processed only after receipt of the same through Diplomatic channel.

- No emoluments will be paid by AIIMS Mangalagiri to the Foreign National candidates.

6. Duration of Course:

- a) Duration of course for all Candidates will commence from date of declaration of entrance examination result (provisional registration) to award of degree.
- b) PhD course will be **full time**.
- c) Duration of three years' course will include previous research experience for transferred Scholars and faculty.
- d) **Minimum Duration:** Shall be for a minimum period of three years including course work.
- e) **Maximum Duration:** Shall be for a period of 6 years.
- f) Extension beyond above limit can be given for a maximum period of 6 months on recommendation of DRC and final approval by Director.
- g) Further extension beyond 6 years and 6 months can only be given by Standing Academic Committee for a maximum period of 06 months (7 years in total) in highly exceptional
- h) circumstances (like medical exigencies, natural calamities etc.) and such extension may not be given retrospectively.
- i) Chief Guide of Candidate shall give clear reasons for delay to Academic Committee and must present case before Academic Committee.
- j) Failure to submit thesis within stipulated time period of maximum 06 years with extension after approval up to 6 Years 6 months (07 years in exceptional cases by prior approval of Academic Committee) shall lead to cancellation of PhD registration of Candidate.
- k) Women Candidates and Persons with Disability (more than 40% disability) may be allowed a relaxation of two years for Ph.D. in maximum duration. In addition, women Candidates may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave once in entire duration of Ph.D. for up to 240 days.
- l) An event of failure of provisionally registered Candidate to clear Research Methodology, Biostatistics and Evidence Based Medicine (EBM) exam during PhD course as conducted by AIIMS Mangalagiri within six months and course work will invalidate his/her candidature for course.

7. Method of Selection and Scheme of Examination:

If any discrepancy in any question is found in the Entrance Examination, the candidates advised to write to Dean (Examination), AIIMS, Mangalagiri – 462020 within 24 hours on the following email: Email dean.exam@aiimsMangalagiri.edu.in. This mail will only be used for discrepancy related to questions. However, for other queries please mail on pa.deana@aiimsmangalagiri.edu.in.

Note:

- I) Any seat may be withdrawn at any given point of time on the recommendation of the competent authority.
- II) All candidates declared eligible for appearing in Interview will be called as per schedule displayed on the website.

Ph.D. Entrance examination to consist of 70 MCQ with marks allotted being 70 Marks.

- Subject Knowledge: 35 Marks (50%)
- Aptitude, Soft skills and General Knowledge: 15 Marks
- Rest of question paper be based on: 20 Marks
 - a) Biostatistics

- b) Research Methodology
- c) Cell Biology
- d) Primary Health Care
- e) General health related Issues

Total Duration: 90 minutes

- Candidates must score at least 50% to be eligible to next level. However, relaxation may be allowed for the Inservice candidates (Faculty, SR, Tutors, permanent staff) of AIIMS Mangalagiri.
- Personal interview with PhD Selection Board: (carrying 30 marks)
- Board shall comprise of Director, Dean (Academic), Dean (Research), Dean (Examination) PhD Convener (Member Secretary PhD Admissions), Prospective Guide, HOD of concerned department, and representative members of SC, ST, OBC, Minority and Women respectively.
- Candidates must score at least 50% marks to be eligible for registration in PhD.
- All Candidates who are enrolled at AIIMS Mangalagiri for PhD course will have to invariably clear Research Methodology, Biostatistics and Evidence Based Medicine (EBM) exam for Ph.D. scholars conducted by AIIMS Mangalagiri in addition to course work.

7.2 Evaluation Procedure:

Each correct (MCQ) answer will be awarded 1 mark. More than one answer will be treated as wrong answer. Zero mark will be given for questions not answered or marked for review.

Note:

I) Result will be available on website of AIIMS, Mangalagiri. No individual intimation will be communicated to Candidate.

II) Whose candidature is not approved by Director will not be eligible for admission.

III) Admission to Ph.D. Course will be subject to availability of Guides/ research funds/fellowship/ grant from recognized funding agencies.

7.3 Final Result: of qualified Candidates will be prepared based on number of vacancies available and availability of approved Guides and Co-guides.

Selected Candidates are required to join within last date of joining as mentioned in result Information uploaded in Institute website. In case Candidate fails to join by this date and no written request for extension is received, it will be assumed that he/she does not intend to join course and seat will be offered to next Candidate on waiting list. No further correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

7.4 Candidates who have qualified in UGC-NET/UGC-CSIR NET, ICMR-JRF/SRF, DBT-JRF/SRF, INSPIRE Fellowship and similar National level tests are exempted from appearing the entrance examination and will be admitted based on interview.

Candidates must score at least 50 percent (35 Marks) in Stage-I to be eligible for Interview.

- Final merit will be made based on the cumulative marks obtained in the stage I + Interview and the final selection list will be available on the website of AIIMS Mangalagiri and notice Board.

8. Admission rules for In-service Candidates:

- Individual should be an employee of AIIMS Mangalagiri.
- He/She should fulfil all eligibility criteria for Ph.D. course.
- Candidate should have a proven track record of active involvement in research / academic activities of department.
- He/she should possess good written and verbal communication skills in English language to be certified by HOD/Chief of Center.
- It is desirable that Candidate should have at least 2 original research publications (not case reports) in a peer reviewed journal.
- Candidate seeking admission under this category will have to identify a faculty member in AIIMS Mangalagiri who is willing to be Chief-Guide of Candidate.
- Candidate should submit a letter of acceptance/undertaking from concerned faculty member in this regard.

8.1 Rules for admission for in-service candidates applicable for AIIMS Employees/other govt. institute-sponsored candidates.

- In-service faculty members and scientists from Govt. Institutes would also be awarded PhD admission, subject to fulfilment of rules and regulations of the respective institute.
- Candidates with their own fellowship can be exempted from the written test and can be directly called for evaluation during the Interview.
- All in-service/sponsored candidates should route the application through proper channel with NOC from the competent authority of the institute.

9. Leaves and other rules:

- It is responsibility of Guide to send attendance details of PhD scholar to PhD convener on regular basis.
- PhD students (who are not Inservice candidates of AIIMS Mangalagiri) are entitled for 30 days leave per year, if leave exceeds limit within a year, then extended period is treated as extraordinary leave and his/her minimum registration will be extended for same duration.
- However extraordinary leave cannot be more than 3 months in entire registration period of 6 years. Any such extension beyond three months shall lead to registration being cancelled.
- Women Candidates may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave as per Govt. rules.
- In case of Chief Guide recommend a Candidate for specific training or project related work outside AIIMS Mangalagiri (within India or abroad). Such period shall be treated as duty academic leave. This study leave shall not be more than 6 months in entire registration period. Proof of acceptance of Candidate for such training work outside should be submitted and on return, report of such training/ work done shall be required to be submitted to Convener PhD by Candidate through Chief Guide.

10.Course Fees:

Each candidate selected for admission will have to pay the following Fees and dues during the duration of the course.

This fee excludes hostel charges and electricity which will be paid separately, if hostel accommodation is provided.

Note: (i) Fees and other charges once paid shall not be refunded in any case and no correspondence will be entertained in this connection.

ii. Fee structure is subject to revision by Director AIIMS Mangalagiri.

- Fees and other charges including hostel rent once paid shall not be refunded in any case and no correspondence will be entertained in this connection. However, the caution money will be refunded to those candidates who do not join the course. The caution money must be claimed within one year after completion of the course failing which it will be forfeited.
- **Hostel Accommodation:** Subject to availability

11.Provision for penalty:

If any candidate joins the Ph.D. program and leaves the said course during the stipulated time, he/she shall be liable to pay a sum of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees two lakhs) or the amount of stipend/salary paid till the date of resignation, whichever is higher for the losses incurred by the AIIMS/Project due to such midterm departure. The stipend/Salary for the month in which her/his resignation from the PhD seat becomes effective shall also stand forfeited. However, any relaxation as requested by the candidate may be considered by the Competent Authority if deemed appropriate.

12.Submission of caste/category certificate by SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PWBD candidates:

- a) After the declaration of the result of the Entrance Examination, candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe, Other Backward Classes, Economically Weaker Section and PwBD should

submit an attested copy of a certificate from any one of the following **authorities stating that the candidate belongs to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe or Other Backward Classes, Economically Weaker Section and PwBD in the prescribed form**

- b) District Magistrate, Additional District Magistrate, Collector, Deputy Commissioner, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Deputy Collector, 1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate, City Magistrate, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Taluka Magistrate, Executive Magistrate, Extra Assistant Commissioner
- c) Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate.
- d) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- e) Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and his or her family normally reside. Administrator/Secretary to Administrator/Development Officer (Lakshadweep Island) or as authorized in the Constitution.
- f) The candidate will be required to submit an undertaking to the effect of their caste. The detection of any discrepancy in the caste certificate shall entail cancellation of registration. This is as per the provisions made by the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions vide their order No. 36033/4/97-Estt. (RES) dated 25.7.2003 and No. 36011/3/2005-Estt. (RES) dated 9.9.2005 respectively.
- g) Candidates must note that a certificate from any other person/authority, as mentioned above will not be accepted and no further correspondence in this regard shall be entertained. The name, designation and the seal of the Officer should be legible on the certificate.

13. Code of conduct for Ph.D. students at AIIMS, Mangalagiri:

I. Maintenance of Discipline among Ph.D. students:

- All powers relating to discipline and disciplinary action are vested with the Director, AIIMS, Mangalagiri.
- The Director, AIIMS may delegate all such powers, as he/she deems proper to the Dean (Academics) and to such other persons as he/she may specify on his behalf without prejudice to the generality of power to enforce discipline under the Rules.
- The following shall amount to acts of gross indiscipline:
- Physical assault or threat to use physical force against any member of the teaching or nonteaching staff of any Department/Centre of AIIMS or any other persons within the premises/ Campus of AIIMS. Carrying or use or threat of use of any weapon.
- Violation of the status, dignity, and honour of students belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Castes, and PwBD.
- Any practice, whether verbal or otherwise, derogatory to women
- Any attempt of bribing or corruption in any manner
- Wilful destruction of institutional property
- Creating ill-will or intolerance on religious or communal grounds
- Disrupting in any manner of the functioning of the AIIMS, Mangalagiri
- Regarding ragging the directive of the Supreme Court will be followed strictly. It is as under: "As per direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the Government has banned ragging completely in any form inside and outside of the campus and the Institute authorities are determined not to allow any form of the ragging. Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in abets or instigates ragging within or outside any educational Institution, shall be suspended, expelled or rusticated from the Institution and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to Rs. 10,000/-. The punishment may also include cancellation of admission suspension from attending the classes,

withholding/withdrawing fellowship/ scholarship and other financial benefits, and withholding or cancelling the result. The decision shall be taken by the Head of the Institution."

- Without prejudice to the generality of his/her powers relating to the maintenance of discipline and taking such action in the interest of maintaining discipline as may seem to him/her appropriate. The Director, may in the exercise of his/her powers aforesaid order or direct that any student or students:
- Be expelled
- Be or be not for a stated period, admitted to a course or courses of study at AIIMS Mangalagiri
- Be fined with a sum of rupees that may be specified
- Be debarred from taking any examination(s) for one or more semesters
- Withhold the result of the concerned student(s) in the Examination(s) in which he/she or they have appeared to be cancelled
- Be prohibited from appearing or completing any examination for any unfair means like copying, taking notes, mobiles or any other electronic gadgets inside the examination halls
- At the time of admission, every student shall be required to sign a declaration that on admission he/she submits himself/herself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Director and several authorities of the AIIMS who may be vested with the authority to exercise discipline under the Acts, the Statutes, the Rules that have been framed there under by competent authorities.

Prohibition of and Punishment for Ragging:

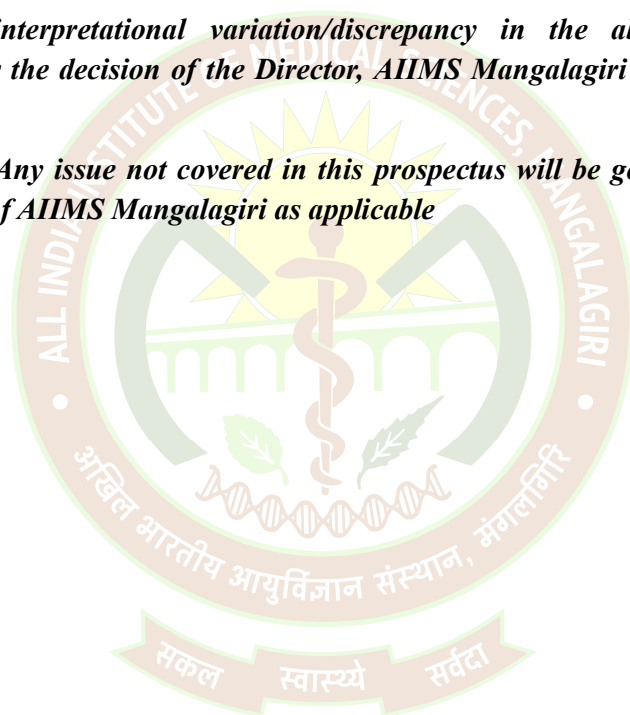
- Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited, within the premises of the College/Department of Institution and any part of AIIMS and also outside the AIIMS Campus.
- Any individual or collective act or practice or ragging constitute gross indiscipline shall be dealt with under these rules.
- Ragging for these rules, ordinarily means any act, conduct or practice by which dominant power or status of senior students is brought to bear on students freshly enrolled or students who are, in any way, considered junior or inferior by other students and includes individual or collective acts or practice which:
- Involve physical assault or threat or use of physical force
- Violate the status, dignity, and honour of women students
- Violate the status, dignity, and honour of students belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Castes
- Expose students to ridicule and contempt and affect their self-esteem
- Entail verbal abuse and aggression, indecent gestures and obscene behaviour
- The Director, Dean, Hostel Superintendent, and Faculty of AIIMS Mangalagiri shall take immediate action on any information of the occurrence of ragging
- Notwithstanding anything in Clause (4) above, the Dean or any other Faculty member/or authority may also *Suo-moto* enquire into any incident of ragging and make a report to the Executive Director of the identity of those who have engaged and the nature of the incident.
- The Dean may also submit an initial report establishing the identity of the perpetrators of ragging and the nature of the ragging incident.
- On the receipt of a report under clause (5) or (6) or a determination by the relevant authority disclosing the occurrence or ragging incidents described under the first three points in Clause 3, the Executive Director shall direct or order rustication of a student or students for a specific number of semesters.
- The Director may in other cases of ragging order or direct that any student or students be expelled or be not, for a stated period, admitted to a course of study as AIIMS, departmental examination for

one or more semesters or that the result of the student or students concerned in the examination(s) in which they appeared to be cancelled.

- In a case where students who have obtained degree(s) of AIIMS are found guilty under this Rules, appropriate action will be taken for withdrawal of degrees conferred by the AIIMS.
- For this Rules, abetment to ragging will also amount to ragging.
- **Internal Complaint Committee:** A statutory committee, comprising of members from the teaching and non-teaching staff as well as students looks into matters related to sexual harassment of students and staff in the college. Any person aggrieved in this matter may fearlessly approach the committee for a fair and concerned hearing and redressal.
- **Unauthorized absence of students:** Unauthorized absence of students will be informed to the students and also Parents or Local Guardians. At least 3 reminders will be issued with a gap of 10 days by the Academic Section to these students. Thereafter the action for cancellation of the registration of the concerned will be decided by the Dean (Academics) / Director, AIIMS Mangalagiri.

For any interpretational variation/discrepancy in the above-mentioned Ph.D. rules/norms the decision of the Director, AIIMS Mangalagiri will be binding to all concerned.
