11. **Selection Process:** Duly constituted 'Standing Selection Committee' will conduct the selection process for all the posts.

- Interviews will be held at AIIMS Mangalagiri and mode as may be decided by the Executive Director, AIIMS Mangalagiri. Candidates called for interview will have to produce all relevant original documents for verification before the interview. They may also be asked to submit an affidavit / declaration regarding as decided by AIIMS Mangalagiri at the time of interview.
- After verification of documents, 'Standing Selection Committee' shall conduct interview/selection process for only eligible candidates against the post they have applied for. Candidates must note that mere appearing in interview does not confer them any right to selection. Candidates have to score minimum qualifying marks (suitability standard) in interview as given below for empanelment in the order of merit for selection. Candidates not scoring the minimum qualifying marks/suitability standard will not be considered for selection irrespective of their merit position.

- The appointment will be subject to review and probation of two years.
- Assessment Promotion: A faculty after rendering fixed years of service on a grade may be considered for assessment promotion subject to the Rules and Regulations applicable from time to time in the Central Government Institutions/AIIMS.
- The appointee shall be on the whole-time appointment of the AIIMS Mangalagiri and shall not accept any other assignment, paid or otherwise and shall not engage himself/herself in a private practice of any kind.
- Canvassing of any kind will lead to disqualification. The prescribed qualification is minimum and mere possessing the same does not entitle any candidate for selection.
- The candidate should not have been convicted by any Court of Law.
- The selected candidate is expected to conform to the rules of conduct and discipline as applicable to the institute employees.
- In case, any information or declaration given by the candidate is found to be false or if the candidate has willfully suppressed any material information relevant to this appointment, he/she will be liable to be removed from the service and/or any action taken as deemed fit by the appointing authority.
